58, beggar. Ross. Jacobite in Cromarty's regiment. Prisoner at Inverness and Tilbury. Transported 20 March 1747

JACK WILLIAM

36. Merchant and messenger. **Elgin**. Jacobite in Strathallan's Horse. Prisoner at Tilbury. Transported to **Barbados** by Samuel Smith 31 March 1747

JACK WILLIAM

Thief. Transported to America, Edinburgh 1752
(SM)

JACKSON ANNE

Forger. Banished for life, at Inverness September 1754
(SM)

JACKSON ANNABEL

Covenanter. Prisoner at Dunnottar and Leith. Banished to the Plantations at Leith 18 August 1685. Transported from Leith by George Scott of Pitlochrie to East New Jersey on the Henry and Francis, master Richard Hutton 5 September 1685

JACKSON JAMES

Royalist soldier captured at Worcester. Transported on the John and Sarah, master John Greene, from Gravesend to Boston 13 May 1652
(NER)

JACKSON JOHN

Servant to Humphrey Colquhoun, Braestob, Glasgow. Covenanter. Prisoner at Glasgow, Canongate and Dunnottar. Banished to the Plantations 30 July 1685. Transported from Leith by John Ewing to Jamaica August 1685

JACKSON PATRICK

Royalist soldier captured at Worcester. Transported on the John and Sarah, master John Greene, from Gravesend to Boston 13 May 1652
(NER)

JACKSON RICHARD

Royalist soldier captured at Worcester. Transported on the John and Sarah, master John Greene, from Gravesend to Boston 13 May 1652
(NER)

JACKSON THOMAS

Covenanter. Prisoner in Thieves' Hole, Edinburgh. Banished to the Plantations 24 July 1685. Transported from Leith to East New Jersey by George Scott of Pitlochrie on the Henry and Francis, master Richard Hutton, 5 September, 1685

JACKSON WALTER

Royalist soldier captured at Worcester. Transported on the John and Sarah, master John Greene, from Gravesend to Boston 13 May 1652
